


### Grade 3 ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

### Grade 8 MATHEMATICS




#### **ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE**

Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.




#### **ON-TIME GRADUATION**
