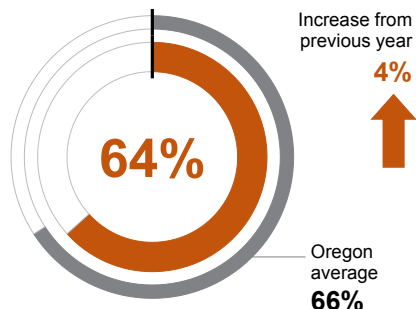

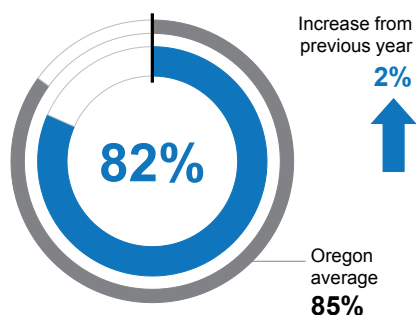

District Goals

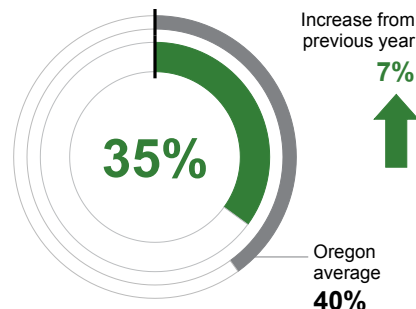

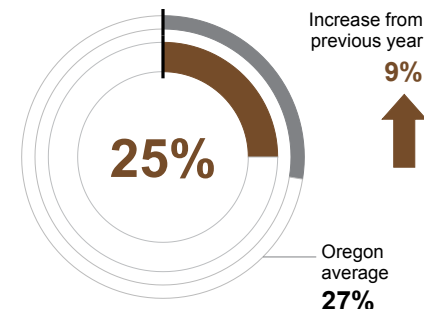

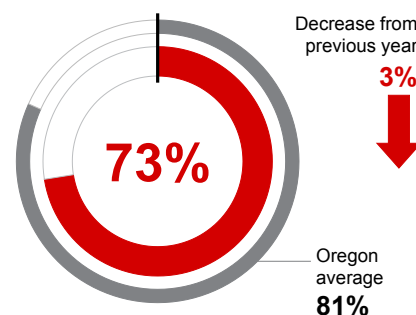
MATHEMATICS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



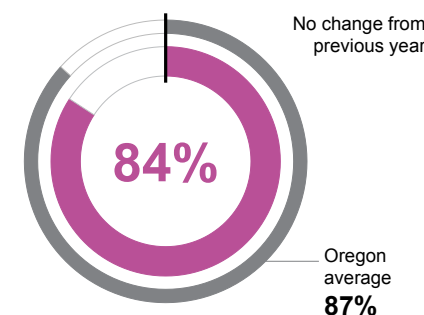
ON-TIME GRADUATION

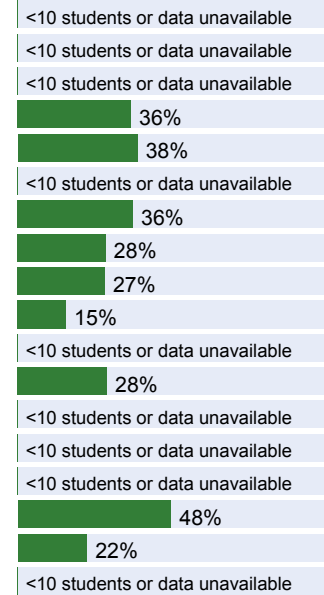

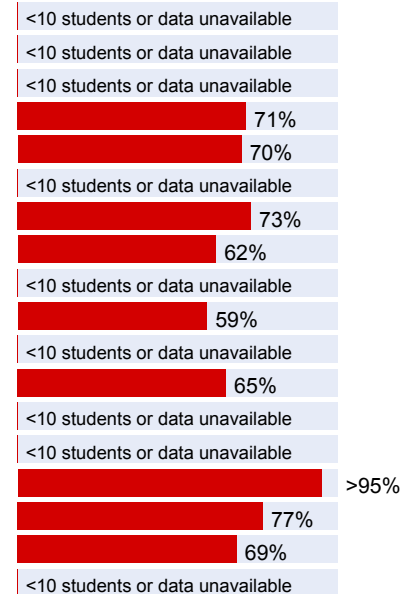

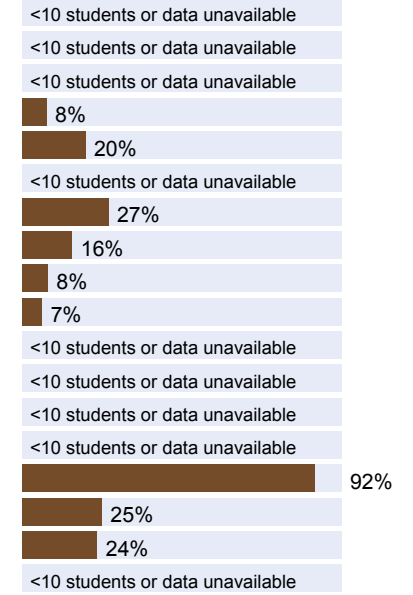
Grade 3 ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS
